Anderson, Margaret. **The Druid's Gift.**

Youth Fiction Anderson

Given the gift of seeing the future, a young girl, living on the tiny and remote island of Hirta at the time of the Druids, is able to travel forward in time and experience some of the important events that shape the history of her island home.

Bond, Nancy. **A String in the Harp.**

Youth Fiction Bond

Relates what happens to three American children, unwillingly transplanted to Wales for one year, when one of them finds an ancient harp-tuning key that takes him back to the time of the great sixth-century bard Taliesin.

Barron, T. A. **The Ancient One.**

While helping her Great Aunt Melanie try to protect an Oregon redwood forest from loggers, thirteen-year-old Kate goes back five centuries through a time tunnel and faces the evil creature Gashra, who is bent on destroying the same forest.

Buckley-Archer, Linda **Gideon the cutpurse : being the first part of the Gideon trilogy.** Youth Fiction Buckley-Archer, L.

Gideon Seymour, an 18th-century gentleman, befriends Peter Schock and Kate Dyer, who have fallen straight from the 21st century as the result of an accident with a cubic antigravity machine from Mr. Dyer's top-secret experiments. Now the future of history is in all their hands.

Buckley-Archer, Linda. **The Time Thief .** Youth Fiction Buckley-Archer, L.

When an attempt to bring Peter and Kate back to their own time is bungled, Peter finds himself stranded in 1763 while The Tar Man, a villainous eighteenth-century criminal, returns with Kate to twenty-first-century London.

Ciencin, Scott. **Dinoverse.**

Juvenile Science Fiction Ciencin

When thirteen-year-old Bertram and three friends find themselves living in dinosaur bodies sixty-seven million years ago, they discover new ways to think about their lives.

Cooney, Caroline B. **Prisoner of Time.**

Youth Fiction Cooney

Attempting to break free from the oppression of women in the nineteenth century, sixteen-year-old Devonny steps through time hoping to find the power to change her fate. Also **Out of Time** and **For All Time**

Cooper, Susan. **King of Shadows.** Juvenile Fiction Cooper
While in London as part of an all-boy acting company preparing to perform in a replica of the famous Globe Theatre, Nat Field suddenly finds himself transported back to 1599 and performing in the original theater under the tutelage of Shakespeare himself.

Ewing, Lynne. **The Choice.** Youth Fiction Ewing
Amid premonitions of her own death, Jimena travels to the past and teams up with her old gang rival, Payasa, to try to save herself and the other goddesses from the evil Atrox and his Followers.

Lasky, Kathryn. **Blood Secret.** Youth Fiction Lasky
Fourteen-year-old Jerry Luna, mute since her mother's disappearance, is sent to her great-great aunt Constanza's house, where she discovers a trunk that draws her into the world of her ancestors during the Spanish Inquisition.

L'Engle, Madeleine. **Many Waters.** Youth Paperback Collection L
The fifteen-year-old Murry twins, Sandy and Dennys, are accidentally sent back to a strange Biblical time period, in which mythical beasts roam the desert and a man named Noah is building a boat in preparation for a great flood.

Levitin, Sonia. **The Cure.** Youth Fiction Levitin
A sixteen-year-old boy living in 2407 collides with the past when he finds himself in Strasbourg in 1348 confronting the anti-Semitism that sweeps through Europe during the Black Plague.

Montes, Marisa. **A Circle of Time.** Youth Fiction Montes
In 1996, a fourteen-year-old girl in a coma is forced back in time by a girl who died in 1906, and who needs help in righting a series of terrible wrongs.

Mowry **Ghost Train** Youth Fiction Mowry
Thirteen-year-old Remi, who has just moved to California from Haiti, and his neighbor Niya travel back in time to solve the mystery of the night train.

Paulsen, Gary. **The Time Hackers.** Juvenile Fiction Paulsen
When someone uses futuristic technology to play pranks on twelve-year-old Dorso Clayman, he and his best friend set off on a supposedly impossible journey through space and time trying to stop the gamesters who are endangering the universe.

Paulsen, Gary. **The Transall Saga.** Youth Fiction Paulsen // Youth PB P
While backpacking in the desert, thirteen-year-old Mark falls into a tube of blue light and is transported into a more primitive world, where he must use his knowledge and skills to survive.

Peck, Richard. **Blossom Culp and the Sleep of Death.** Youth Fiction Peck
Blossom, high-school freshman and possessor of "second sight," helps an Egyptian princess, dead for 3500 years, to regain her tomb, and in addition saves a suffragette school teacher from losing her job in 1914.

Voigt, Cynthia. **Building Blocks.** Youth Fiction Paperback V

In a trip back in time, Brann meets his father as a ten-year-old and learns for the first time to love and understand him.

Wells, H. G. **The Time Machine.**

Science Fiction Paperback Wells

A young scientist, to the amazement and disbelief of his colleagues and other experts, has perfected a machine that lets him live one of mankind's oldest dreams--to live in times other than his own.

Whitmore, Arvella. **Trapped Between the Lash and the Gun : A Boy's Journey.** Juvenile Fiction Whitmore

Twelve-year-old Jordan is becoming dangerously involved with a street gang when he is suddenly transported through time to become a slave on the plantation of his ancestors.

Yolen, Jane. **The Devil's Arithmetic.**

Hannah resents stories of her Jewish heritage and of the past until, when opening the door during a Passover Seder, she finds herself in Poland during World War II where she experiences the horrors of a concentration camp, and learns why she-- and we need to remember the past.
